The KEMP pilot course took place in Madrid, Spain on 23<sup>rd</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> March 2009. In this event the project partnership had the chance to test both the training curriculum (trainees manual) and the instructors guide (trainers manual).

The pilot course was attended by 11 participants from 6 different European Countries, to whom it was asked to evaluate the session, the contents and the materials, among other dimensions.

The conclusions of this assessment showed a high satisfaction of the participants towards the course, which has been considered as very useful and well prepared. Most of them stated to have gain news knowledge and skills that can contribute to make their both personal and professional lives, easier. Moreover, they assumed that the course was also an opportunity for them to improve their language skills, since it has been delivered in English.

By the end of the course, most of the participants felt more motivated to use these “new” skills to enhance certain aspects of their jobs or businesses.

Based on the assessment made, the following strengths of KEMP course were pointed:

- The applicability of the trainees manual in both professional and personal life context;
- The exercises are built in order to encourage the active involvement of participants;
- Originality of the offer of e-skills.
